- Easter Bingo: Each player has a bingo board. Cut out the picture cards on the last page. One person picks a card at a time and calls it out – cover it up if you have it on your board. Winner is the first to complete a line, or to cover their whole board.
- Easter Egg Hunt: Print out a copy of the game board per player. Who can spot the most eggs in 1 minute?
- Pin the tail on the Easter bunny: Print the poster and bunny tails, find a blindfold or scarf and have fun!
