Significant moment

In order to gain a wider picture of your child we would appreciate you recording any significant moments that happen with your child outside school throughout the next year. Please record each significant moment on a separate sheet and bring the sheet to school when a significant moments taken place. I have attached a blank sheet for you.

Examples of significant moments could include:

- Sarah had a new bike for her birthday. She rode her bike without any stabilisers (could include a photo of Sarah riding her bike). Sarah was very proud of herself.

- John swam the width of the swimming pool today (may have got swimming badge/certificate – could bring this into school to show everyone).
- Any awards/certificates that the children have achieved outside of school. Write how they achieved them.
- On the computer Sam showed me that he could write his name, finding all the letters in his name on the keyboard. He then went on to move the mouse and paint a picture of himself on a painting program (could print this and include in significant moment).
- We were cooking at home and Katy used the weighing scales showing me how to use them because she had used them at school when weighing out the ingredients needed for cakes.
- Joe was drawing at home and he drew a picture of the family and for the first time I have seen him write his name correctly (could bring in drawing so that we could photocopy it). I was very excited and proud of him.
