All pupils in Year 4 take part in a multiplication check. The check has 25 questions and tests pupils on their multiplication facts. Pupils only have 6 seconds per question. The Government does not release a pass mark for this but does release average data. Those pupils below the average score will continue to receive support the following academic year
